

PUBLIC AUCTION OF FARM PRODUCE

The auction of fruits yields at ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal up to 31.03.2028 will be held on **16.03.2026 at 11.00 A.M** by public auction. The details of the fruit plants in the Orchard are as given below:-

The terms and conditions will be as under:

1. The Director, ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal reserves the right to accept or reject any of all bids without assigning any reason.
2. All the bidders will have to deposit a sum of **Rs. 10,000/-** (Rupees Ten Thousand only) before the start of the bidding process. The same will be refunded to unsuccessful bidders after the bid is over.
3. The bidder may inspect the standing crops to be auctioned on any working day starting from 23.02.2026 (from 9.30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) with the permission of Horticulture In-charge, ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal or any other nominated Officer.
4. In case the highest bid is accepted on the spot, the highest bidder will have to pay 20% on the spot of the highest bid. Balance 40 % will be payable within 7 working days and rest amount of will be payable during the first week of **March, 2027**. All payments may be made through digital mode.
5. Bidders/tenderers are at liberty to be present or authorize in writing a representative to be present at the time of auction.
6. There should be no damage to the orchards or fencing of the boundary etc. In case there is any damage, the successful bidder would bear the cost of the damage.

7. Any tax as applicable shall have to be paid by the successful bidder.
8. Produce except those auctioned will not be allowed to be removed. In the case the highest bidder or his worker is found doing so the contract will be nullified and the money deposited for the purpose will be forfeited.
9. The In-charge Horticulture Unit or any of the nominated person will have freedom to visit/inspect the orchard area at any time.
10. The watch and ward for all the produce will be responsibilities of the contractor failing which the present contractor will be nullified and will be black listed from the future auction.
11. Firewood should not be used for cooking etc. in the orchard in any case. If any worker is found doing so the contractor will have to pay the penalty fixed by the Director, ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal.
12. If any fire occurs due to the negligence of the contractor or workers, the contractor has to pay the damage cost fixed by the Director, ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal.
13. The contractor cannot sub-lease the contract further.
14. The contractor will not be allowed to keep the family in the orchard and the worker will stay adjacent to the orchard for guarding the fruits in a temporary hut only.
15. Contractor will not be allowed to remove, damage any property of the ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal. Contrary to this necessary action as mentioned under the terms and conditions will taken.
16. After completion of contract, the contractor is required to hand over the same number of fruit trees which he has received at the time of auctioning/award of contract to the Farm In-charge, ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal.
17. Sale of the produce in the orchard area will not be allowed in any case.
18. The contractor is not allowed to grow any other crop in the orchard area.
19. The contractor is not allowed to pluck fruits being grown in residential area of ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal
20. The Contractor will be required to intimate the name of the person with full address and photocopy of identity required for entering in the orchard or for watch and ward purpose to the In-charge, Horticulture Unit, ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal.
21. The Director, ICAR-NBAGR will not bear any cost on account of salary and other allowance to the workers to be deployed by the contractor.
22. The entire contract will be nullified and the money deposited for the purpose will stand forfeited in the event of the violation of the above terms and conditions and in no circumstances will be allowed to subject the contract further.

23. The successful tenderer/bidder would be responsible for maintenance of all the fruits trees. All the operations including manuring, watering, weeding, pruning, insect-pest management, bird scaring, guarding, harvesting and transportation will be carried out by the successful bidder at his own cost. The organisation will provide only water required for watering of trees/plants.
24. The successful tenderer/bidder would ensure maintenance of the orchard at highest standard and will cooperate in all respect towards the same.
25. It shall be the responsibilities of the successful tendered/bidder to meet all the requirements as prescribed under the various laws and statutes, as in force and amended from time to time. Failure to comply with the applicable labour laws, rules and regulations shall entail necessary action as mandated under the respective laws and also blacklisting by the Director ICAR-NBAGR, Karnal.
26. NBAGR will not be liable for any kind of damage, injury to the contractor or his labourer working in the Institute during the contract period.
27. The successful tenderer/bidder should execute an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- within one week from the date of acceptance.
